EVERYONE IS WELCOME TO THIS FREE EVENT! Because this airport is in Class D airspace with no control tower, Conway is ultralight and light sport friendly as well as GA of course. We have fuel on field. Please note that a recent change makes both runways left hand pattern. Pattern altitude of 1000 feet AGL for general aviation and 500 feet for ultralights. If you have a radio, use 122.7 MHz.

There is usually a huge turnout so arrive early as the food usually does not last past 1 or 2 p.m.
